

Tarpy Tailors Male Measurement & Order Form

An Illustrated Guide Showing The Easiest Way To Take Correct Measurements



Coat Length

Turn up collar — start tape at collar seam (A) (not top of collar) and measure down to (C) the actual length wanted. The same procedure is applicable for topcoat length.



Back Width

(FOR VERTICAL BACK WIDTH ONLY) Place tape at middle of back "center seam" (D) and continue across to (E) where seam of coat starts prior to back.



Sleeve Inseam

Insert tape attachment in armpit (X) where sleeve joins body of coat and measure to length desired (Y).



Breast Measure

Place tape horizontally around body (K) close up under arms and check to see that it is centered well over shoulder blades in back and over fullest part of the breast in front. DO NOT draw tape snug tight or allow it to sag.



Overarm Measurement

Place tape horizontally over both arms, one-two inches above the regular breast measurement. Do not draw tape snug tight or allow it to sag.



Trouser Outside Seam

Adjust trousers to waist position customarily worn by customer. Start tape from the TOP of the waistband and measure to length desired.



Trouser Inside Seam

Keep trousers in the same position as in taking out seam, place tape attachment in crotch at crotch seam and measure to length desired.



Trouser Waist Measure

Measure around waist just above trouser waistband (M) over the shirt. Do not measure over vest, belt or waistband. Take measure exact. Do not allow tape to sag.



Seat Measure

Be sure customer's hip pockets are empty and legs are together before applying tape. Then measure around fullest part of seat (O). Hold tape line sufficiently easy to permit sliding fingers under it.



Bottom and Knee Measure

Hold trousers at front crease pulling leg toward you. Place tape at back crease and bring around over cuff to starting point. Follow same procedure in taking knee measure.

Please list any size problems you may have. Such as extra wide shoulders, large thighs, arms etc....
